2.2.0 General

2.2.1 Product Description

CBI8110IFH is a Network Camera (IP Camera) designed and manufactured by Costar Video Systems. This camera provides Full HD (3840 x 2160) resolution at 30 ips (images per second) with H.264/MJPEG compression. This camera is equipped with Motorized Focus/Zoom lens, True Day/Night, PoE (IEEE 802.3af Class 3), IR LED, White LED, Alarm Output, Vandal-proof bullet enclosure design and IP66 rated and provides continuous operation in subzero temperature.

2.2.2 General Specification

- 1. The IP camera shall be equipped with 8 Megapixel 1/2.5" CMOS Sensor.
- 2. The IP camera shall be equipped with 3.6mm 9.8mm Motorized Vari-focal lens, F1.6 3.2.
- 3. The IP camera shall be a true day/night camera with a mechanical filter for low light performance. The filter can be switched remotely, or automatically via a light level sensor or contact input (ICR).
- 4. The IP camera shall have Wide dynamic range compensation (Digital WDR) for improved video quality in high-contrast situations (more than 69 dB).
- 5. The IP camera shall be equipped with 10ea Infrared LED with range up to 30m (98.4ft).
- 6. The IP camera shall utilize 2DNR/3DNR (Dynamic Noise Reduction) technology to reduce the bitrate and storage requirements by removing noise artifacts.
- 7. The IP camera shall be Vandal-Proof and IP rating 66 complied dome enclosure design.
- 8. IP camera shall be equipped with 10/100 Base-T, auto-sensing, half/full duplex, RJ45 Ethernet connection.
- 9. The IP camera shall have built-in heater for continued use in subzero temperature conditions and utilize 12 VDC input to provide power.
- 10. The IP camera shall support industry standard Power over Ethernet (PoE) IEEE 802.3af, Class 3



- to supply power to the camera over the network and 12VDC input.
- 11. The IP camera shall have video out feature (NTSC/PAL).
- 12. The IP camera shall be equipped with video stream buffer memory (60MB) to counter pre/post event buffering and network delays for improved network recording reliability.
- 13. The IP camera shall deliver maximum video resolution of 3840 x 2160 at rates up to 30ips (images per second).
- 14. The IP camera shall provide direct network connection using H.264 and MJPEG** compression (** iNEX Protocol only).
- 15. The IP camera shall support Quadruple Streams in DirectNET protocol mode.
- 16. The IP camera shall support Quadruple Streams in iNEX protocol mode.
- 17. The IP camera shall conform to the ONVIF** Profile S Ver 2.4.0 standard (** iNEX Protocol only).
- 18. The IP camera shall be equipped with embedded web server (Webguard**) which works independently using a Web Browser with ActiveX plug-in (** iNEX Protocol only).
- 19. The IP camera shall have IP filtering, HTTPS, SSL, IEEE 802.1X, and configurable user authority levels for greater security.
- 20. The IP camera shall have network bandwidth limitation and MAT features for more efficient use of network bandwidth.
- 21. The IP camera shall have Easy network access via UPnP (Universal Plug and Play) function and embedded mDNS (Multicast DNS) protocol.
- 22. The IP camera shall have Intelligent Video Analysis (VA): Motion Detection, Active Tampering Alarm and Trip Zone.

2.2.3 Protocol Specification: DirectNET and iNEX Protocol

- 1. The IP camera shall have 2 protocol modes, DirectNET and iNEX Protocol, and DirectNET is set as main protocol by default.
- 2. The protocol modes shall be selectable between DirectNET and iNEX protocol mode to meet specific needs with iNIT Discovery tool.
 - DirectNET Protocol
 - A. DirectNET protocol shall provide easy connection to DirectNET NVR for automatic discovery and video streaming configuration.
 - B. DirectNET protocol shall provide quadruple streams.
 - C. The bitrate shall be automatically adjusted by recording profile of DirectNET NVR.
 - D. DirectNET protocol shall support H.264 only as primary compression.
 - iNEX Protocol
 - A. iNEX protocol shall provide the compatibility with StarNET VMS, iNEX VMS or ONVIF for third-party software solutions.
 - B. iNEX protocol shall provide quadruple streams.



C. iNEX protocol shall support H.264 and MJPEG compression.
